St Hugh's School Boarding Boys' Clothing List

1 school blazer
3 white shirts (long or short sleeved)
2 school ties

2 navy slipover
3 pairs of grey shorts (Years 1 to 5) OR
3 pairs of dark grey trousers (Years 6 to 8)
4 pairs of school socks
(grey ankle socks may be worn with trousers)
Black shoes (no suede or boots, please)
School coat

School cap (summer)
School hat (winter)

School water bottle
4 pairs of pants
3 vests (optional)
3 pairs of pyjamas
1 dressing gown
1 pair of slippers
2 face flannels
1 hairbrush and comb
Sponge bag
Shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, toothmug (plastic)
4 bath towels (a tape loop for hanging needs to be sewn on the middle of the long side)

General Kit

1 duvet and 2 covers, 1 pillow and 2 pillow slips
1 trunk or large suitcase
Shoe cleaning kit (sponge on liquid preferred)
1 mug (preferably unbreakable)
School sports bag

Play Clothing (Full boarders only)

2 pairs of jeans/jogging trousers/shorts
1 shirt/t-shirt
1 jumper/sweater
1 pair of socks

Notes:

1. All clothing, including underwear, must be clearly marked with a woven name tape (e.g. Cash's) Please send in at least 24 spare name tapes in an envelope that we may keep in school
2. Games Clothing must be named on the inside of the garment.
3. All footwear should also be clearly named with either Clark's/Cash's stick in shoe labels, a glued in woven tape or a waterproof pen.
4. At the beginning of each term, all games clothing should be brought into school on the first day. They will be laundered at school and sent home at the end of term.
5. All play clothes must be machine washable and able to be tumble-dried
6. Boys are not allowed to wear any jewellery or use hair products (e.g. gel) or spray deodorants

Extra equipment needed when entering the school

Year 3 and above: school hymn book, pencil, rubber, set of coloured pencils, pencil sharpener and 30cm ruler in a pencil case. Please ensure all items are named.

Year 5 and above: a handwriting pen or a fountain pen with a supply of washable blue ink cartridges. No biros

Year 6 and above: Transparent protractor, pair of compasses and a Casiofx-83ES scientific calculator, The Head of Maths will order calculators at a discounted rate which ensures all children have the same model of calculator
