St Hugh's School Boarding Girls Clothing List

1 School blazer	4 pairs of pants (pale colours only, please)
3 White blouses (long or short sleeved)	2 vests (optional)
2 School ties	6 handkerchiefs or a box of tissues
1 Navy slipover	3 pairs of pyjamas
2 School kilts	1 dressing gown
4 pairs navy tights or knee-high socks	1 pair slippers
Black shoes (no suede or boots, please)	2 face flannels
School coat	1 hairbrush and comb
School cap (summer)	Sponge bag
School hat (winter)	Shower cap
School water bottle	Shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, toothmug (preferably unbreakable)
	4 bath towels (loop sewn on middle of long side)

NB. Summer uniform (i.e. summer dress and plain white ankle socks) is worn after the first Exeat of the summer term and may be worn at the beginning of the autumn term.

General Kit

1 duvet and 2 covers, 1 pillow and 2 pillow slips
1 trunk or large suitcase
Shoe cleaning kit (sponge on liquid preferred)
1 mug (preferably unbreakable)
School sports bag

Play Clothing (full boarders only)

2 pairs of jeans/jogging trousers/shorts
1 blouse/t-shirt
1 jumper/sweatshirt
1 pair of socks

Notes:

1. All clothing, including underwear, must be clearly marked with a woven name tape (e.g. Cash's) that is sewn in on the inside.
Please send in at least 24 spare name tapes in an envelope that we may keep in school.
2. All footwear should also be clearly named with either Clark's/Cash's stick in shoe labels, a glued in woven tape or a waterproof pen.
3. At the beginning of each term, all games clothing should be brought into school on the first day. They will be laundered at school and sent home at the end of term.
4. Hairbands, scrunchies, slides etc. should be plain red, navy, white or tortoiseshell
5. Jewellery is not permitted, except for girls with pierced ears who may wear small, plain, gold ear studs.
6. All play clothes must be machine washable and able to be tumble-dried
7. Girls are not allowed make-up, nail varnish, hair products (e.g. gel) or spray deodorants in school.

Extra equipment needed when entering the school

Year 3 and above: school hymn book, pencil, rubber, set of coloured pencils, pencil sharpener and 30cm ruler in a pencil case. Please ensure all items are named.

Year 5 and above: a handwriting pen or a fountain pen with a supply of washable blue ink cartridges. No biros

Year 6 and above: Transparent protractor, pair of compasses and a Casiofx-83ES scientific calculator, The Head of Maths will order calculators at a discounted rate which ensures all children have the same model of calculator.
