The presentation of the trophies will follow the completion of the finals.

### Competition Rules

1. All matches to be 5 overs per innings.
  2. Each player may bowl 1 over per match with the exception of the wicket-keeper.
  3. Squads are to be no more than 8 players.
  4. A player must retire if his score reaches 25, but may return to bat if the rest of the team is dismissed.
  5. The last man does not stand.
  6. Normal cricket rules apply – with the exception of: “2 runs will be awarded for a wide or a no-ball, but no extra delivery is necessary unless it is in the final over of the innings”
  7. The team scoring most runs in their innings will win. In the event of a tie, the team losing the fewer wickets will be declared the winner. If the teams are still level, the match will be declared a tie.
- Points:                    2 points = Win                    1 point = Tie
8. Each school must provide an umpire and a scorer – some schools may wish for the umpire to also score from the middle.
  9. Score sheets will be provided by Pocklington Prep School before each game, and must be handed back after each match.
  10. If two teams are tying, the following applies:
    - i. The team winning the original team match will go through.
    - ii. If it was a tie, the team losing the least wickets in the league will go through.
    - iii. If the teams are still level on points at the end of the group matches, and have lost the same number of wickets in the league the final positions will be decided by each team bowling at unguarded wickets. Each team will use five different bowlers. If the teams are still level, sudden death will apply – using the same five bowlers in the same order.
