Only one more week till February Half Term; the time has flown by!

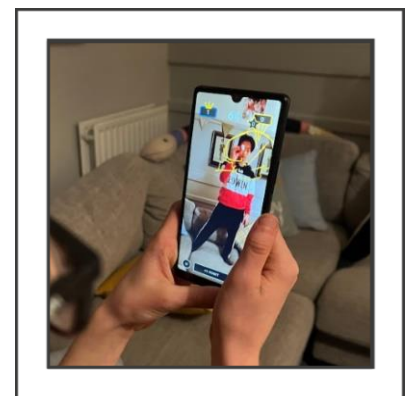

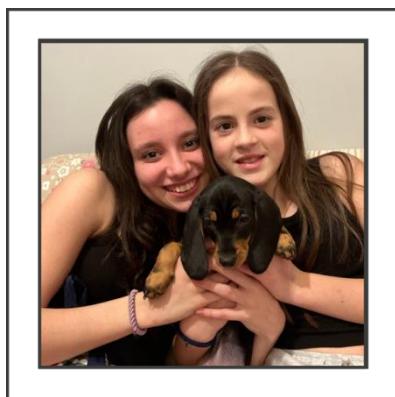
